Who funds the events?

Our Schools Programme is funded by the Welsh Government and Hay Festival Foundation, as part of our commitment to education and the community.

How do I book tickets?

All bookings are handled by aine@hayfestival.org. You can request tickets by submitting the supplied booking form via post or email. Bookings will be dealt with in order of receipt. The closing date for applications is 13 April 2017.

Do we need to prepare the pupils?

Your pupils will get far more out of their visit if they have had the chance to read some of the books by the authors they are going to hear speak. They will know what questions they want to ask and be much more engaged with the event. Pupils are welcome to bring their own books to be signed by the authors. The Festival Bookshop will have books by all the authors appearing at the festival on sale. Schools can arrange to buy books in advance at a discounted rate – we will send you an order form, to be returned by 2 May.

Can we go to more than one event?

You can attend as many events as you wish, as long as there is space available.

Can we bring a large group of children to the festival site?

The site is designed for safety and comfort. Each school will be greeted on arrival and guided to their first venue. Festival staff will be on hand throughout the day to answer queries. The site has full security, with a comprehensive lost child procedure.

Are the events accessible?

Yes, our venues are wheelchair-accessible and have infra-red audio loops for students with hearing difficulties.

Can we bring packed lunches?

Yes, there is plenty of space on site for pupils to relax and enjoy themselves during the lunch break. In the event of rain, everyone will stay dry inside the tents.

Is there anywhere we can buy tea and coffee on site?

The Friends Café will be open throughout the two Schools Programme days, serving tea, coffee, drinks and snacks.

Where should we park?

The Festival has parking on site for minibuses. Coaches may pull into the lay-by outside the site on Brecon Road for drop-offs but must leave the site via Glasbury. Drivers may then park free of charge in the designated coach area at Baskerville Hall Hotel. At the end of the day, coaches will be called and directed when their pupils are ready to depart. There is a compulsory one-way system in operation travelling from Baskerville Hall Hotel car park through Hay town to the site. Coaches must depart via Glasbury. A letter with further information will follow.


Ble ddylem ni barcio?

Jim Smith, creator of the hilarious Barry Loser series, won the Roald Dahl Funny Prize in 2013 for *I am Still not a Loser*, his second book in the Barry Loser series, each of which is packed full of silly humour, quirky plots and doodles. Despite his name, Barry Loser could be a cool kid except that he has some deadly enemies such as Darren Darrenofski who makes his life a misery. How can Barry ever be really cool? And does it matter as much as he thinks? Jim Smith will introduce his stories with lots of humour and some live draw-a-longs. He will show how to draw Barry and his mates, and he may draw live portraits of children in the audience, too



Steve Mould is a TV presenter whose most recent appearances include presenting *I Never Knew That About Britain*. He is also the author of *How to be a Scientist*. Despite being a disaster in the laboratory at school, Mould discovered some incredibly cool science, 'The Mould Effect', at the age of 35. He will explain what this is and reveal the secrets of his mistakes and explain how to learn from them. Through exciting experiments he'll prove that there is science all around and why, as a scientist, you can't always trust your own senses. He will also illustrate just how much fun can be had with science, including how to prank your friends and family with its power.



In *Who Let the Gods Out?* this debut author has created a wildly fun-filled story in which the Greek gods come crashing into the present day. Things are tough for Elliot. His mum is ill, his home is under threat and the future looks bleak. But then a shooting star crashes to Earth and Virgo, a goddess from the Zodiac signs, enters his life. Virgo and Elliot accidentally release a wicked demon who has been imprisoned under Stonehenge. Only the Olympian gods can help them. The trouble is that Zeus and his friends are unpredictable to say the least. Evans uses the world of her hilarious novel *Who Let the Gods Out?* to introduce Greek Mythology – as you've never heard it before. Join Maz as she takes you through the wacky world of the gods and shows you how to create your own hero.



Ardagh's *The Secret Diary of John Drawbridge* is a clever blend of fact and fiction. Propelled by great characters, it is full of exciting historical facts, as young John Drawbridge goes off to train to become a knight. Previously a winner of the Roald Dahl Funny Prize, Ardagh includes lots of jokes as he shows just how much there is to learn in order to become a knight. How to charge with a lance on horseback without falling off, for example. Or, why the plates served at banquets are made of stale bread (and why you shouldn't eat them).

Mae llyfr Ardagh, *The Secret Diary of John Drawbridge*, yn gyfuniad clyfar o ffaith a ffuglen. Wedi'i yrru gan gymeriadau gwych, mae'n llawn ffeithiau hanesyddol cyffrous ac yn adrodd hanes y John Drawbridge ifanc, sy'n hyfforddi i fod yn farchog. Yn gyn-enillydd Gwobr 'Funny' Roald Dahl, mae Ardagh yn cynnwys llawer o jôcs wrth iddo ddangos beth yn union y mae angen ei ddysgu er mwyn bod yn farchog. 

11.15AM STEVE COLE



The best-selling children's author and lifelong fan of Ian Fleming's *James Bond* has previously written *Doctor Who* stories and *AstroSauRs*. *Red Nemesis* is the fourth and final Young Bond adventure, a series charting the adventures of James Bond as a boy, before he became the world's most famous spy. Cole will talk about his final, explosive Young Bond adventure, giving a unique insight into the political tensions that were building in Europe in the 1930s, and explain the gadgetry of the era. The event is interactive as the writer shares the research behind his creation, explains how he became such a fan of Ian Fleming's super-spy and introduces new characters.

Mae'r awdur poblogaidd – a'r ffan pybyr o gymeriad Ian Fleming, James Bond – hefyd wedi ysgrifennu straeon i Doctor Who a AstroSauRs. *Red Nemesis* yw'r pedwerydd llyfr – a'r olaf – yng nghyfres y Bond ifanc ac mae'n adrodd hanes James Bond yn fachgen, cyn iddo ddod yn ysbïwr enwocaf y byd. Bydd Cole yn siarad am yr antur olaf ffrwydrol, yn cynnig cipolwg unigryw ar y tensiynau gwleidyddol yn Ewrop yn y 1930au ac yn esbonio dyfeisiadau'r cyfnod hefyd. Bydd y digwyddiad yn rhyngweithiol a bydd yr awdur yn rhannu'r gwaith ymchwil y tu ôl i'w waith, gan esbonio sut y daeth i fod yn gymaint o ffan o siwper-ysbïwr Ian Fleming. Bydd hefyd yn cyflwyno ambell gymeriad newydd.

11.15AM GARY NORTHFIELD



Northfield is a master cartoonist who has been writing and drawing comics since 2002. He is most famous for *Derek the Sheep* – a comic strip in *The Beano*. He has also created comics for *The Phoenix*, *The Dandy*, *Horrible Histories* magazine, *The Magical World of Roald Dahl*. One of his favourite subjects to write and draw is animals and their jolly lives, as he wonders what they think about the world they live in. *Julius Zebra: Rumble with the Romans* is full of Roman facts and drawing tips for budding young cartoonists. Julius is no ordinary Zebra – he is really a Roman Gladiator. He was captured by slavers from the desert plains and, unlikely as it sounds, has become the favourite gladiator in Rome. Now, in *Bundle with the Britons*, Julius thinks he's going on his jolly holibobs to the swamps of Britain, where he has to prove his worth to win his freedom.

Mae Northfield yn gartwnydd arbennig a fu'n ysgrifennu ac yn darlunio comics ers 2002. Ei greadigaeth enwocaf yw *Derek the Sheep* – comic a gyhoeddwyd yn *The Beano*. Mae e hefyd wedi creu comics ar gyfer *The Phoenix*, *The Dandy*, cylchgrawn *Horrible Histories* a *The Magical World of Roald Dahl*. Un o'i hoff bynciau yw anifeiliaid a'u bywydau hwyliog, ac mae e'n ceisio ystyried beth fyddai eu barn nhw am y byd o'u cwmpas. Mae *Julius Zebra: Rumble with the Romans* yn llawn ffeithiau Rhufeinig a chyngorion darlunio i gartwnwyr ifanc. Nid sebra cyffredin mo Julius – mewn gwirionedd, mae e'n gladiator Rhufeinig. Cafodd ei gymryd yn gaethwas yng ngwastadeddau'r anialwch ac, yn annisgwyl ddigon, ef bellach yw ffefryn pawb o blith y gladiatoriad yn Rhufain. Yn *Bundle with the Britons*, mae Julius yn credu ei fod yn mynd ar wyliau i gorsydd Prydain ond mae'n rhaid iddo brofi ei werth er mwyn ennill ei ryddid.

As a child, Phil Earle wanted to be a professional footballer or a singer. He didn’t like reading fiction but he did like comics and he learnt to love books when he worked in a children’s bookshop.



This poet, novelist and playwright has had eight books, two film scripts and three theatre plays produced to date. For many years he ran a Hulme-based carnival band called Moko Jumbi (Ghosts of the Gods), which took to the streets at Manchester Caribbean Carnival every July on three-feet-high stilts. Watch Kalu pull off the tricks of his writing trade – he can tightrope walk, unicycle and juggle – and learn how he weaves these tricks into his novels, where they are metaphors for frustration, adventure and daring. The author has also spent time dressed up as a zombie and acting in a film as a corpse. Learn how to be a corpse and enter his zombie competition. Kalu will also ask you to join him in re-enacting his sporting disasters (costumes supplied). All the content relates back to his three YA novels *The Silent Striker*, *Being Me* and *Zombie XI*.




