The Schools Programme is designed to inspire pupils in Key Stages 2, 3 and 4 with a range of events, free for all state schools, as part of our commitment to young people. It is funded for this purpose by the Welsh Government and Hay Festival Foundation.

On Thursday 24 May (KS 2) and Friday 25 May (KS 3 and 4), we will welcome thousands of children to our site. Pupils and teachers will have the chance to meet and engage with writers, performers and scientists. They will also have the opportunity to explore topics from equality, positive self-esteem, empathy and the importance of campaigning, to space, discovery and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics).

The Festival has a fabulous bookshop, where you can browse to your heart's content. The books of all of the writers and performers taking part will be on sale, along with hundreds of other titles. The writers will be on hand after their events giving everyone in the audience a wonderful opportunity to get a book signed, to get a selfie and to ask further questions.

This year, we have programmed two start times each day to ease traffic so that all schools can get to the site more easily. When you book your tickets online please select EITHER a 10am start (finish time 1.45pm) OR an 11.15 start (finish time 3pm). Both schedules offer the chance to see exactly the same events, and enjoy the same book-signing opportunities.

We look forward to welcoming you to these hugely enjoyable and inspiring days in which writers and readers are connected at entertaining and informative events designed especially for schools.





Is there a travel bursary?

Schools in Wales can apply for the **Arts Council Wales ‘Go and See’ fund** to cover travel costs - you must apply before your visit. It is a good idea to apply as soon as you send in your booking form. You can also use the **Pupil Deprivation Grant** to cover travel costs.

How do I book tickets?

All bookings are done digitally. You can request tickets by submitting the booking form online. The closing date for applications is 30 April 2018. If you have any queries email schools@hayfestival.com.

Can pupils buy books at the Festival?

Yes, the Festival bookshop will have books by all the authors on sale at a discounted price. Pupils can have their books signed on the day and are also welcome to bring their own books to be signed.

Can we go to more than one event?

You can attend as many events as you wish, as long as there is space available, but you can only select events from your chosen arrival time, either 10am start (for any events at 10am, 11.15am and 1pm – finish time 1.45pm) or 11.15am start (for any events at 11.15am, 1pm and 2.15pm – finish time 3pm).

Can we bring a large group of children to the Festival site?

The site is designed for safety and comfort. Each school will be greeted on arrival and guided to their first venue. Festival staff will be on hand throughout the day to answer queries. The site has full security, with a comprehensive lost child procedure.

Are the events accessible?

Yes, our venues are wheelchair-accessible and have infra-red audio loops for students with hearing difficulties.



Can we bring packed lunches?

Yes, there is plenty of space on site for pupils to relax and enjoy themselves during the lunch break. In the event of rain, everyone will stay dry inside the tents.

Is there anywhere we can buy tea and coffee on site?

The Friends Café will be open throughout the two Schools Programme days, serving tea, coffee, drinks and snacks.

Where should we park?

The Festival has parking on site for minibuses. Coaches may pull into the lay-by outside the site on Brecon Road for drop-offs but must leave the site via Glasbury. Drivers may then park free of charge in the designated coach area at Baskerville Hall Hotel. At the end of the day, coaches will be called and directed when their pupils are ready to depart. There is a compulsory one-way system in operation travelling from Baskerville Hall Hotel car park through Hay town to the site. Coaches must depart via Glasbury. A letter with further information will follow.

Who funds the events?

Our Schools Programme is funded by the Welsh Government and Hay Festival Foundation, as part of our commitment to education and the community.







Mr Gum and Natboff!








The Bolds




Secret Tales from Wales




Dear Katie








Things a Bright Girl Can Do






